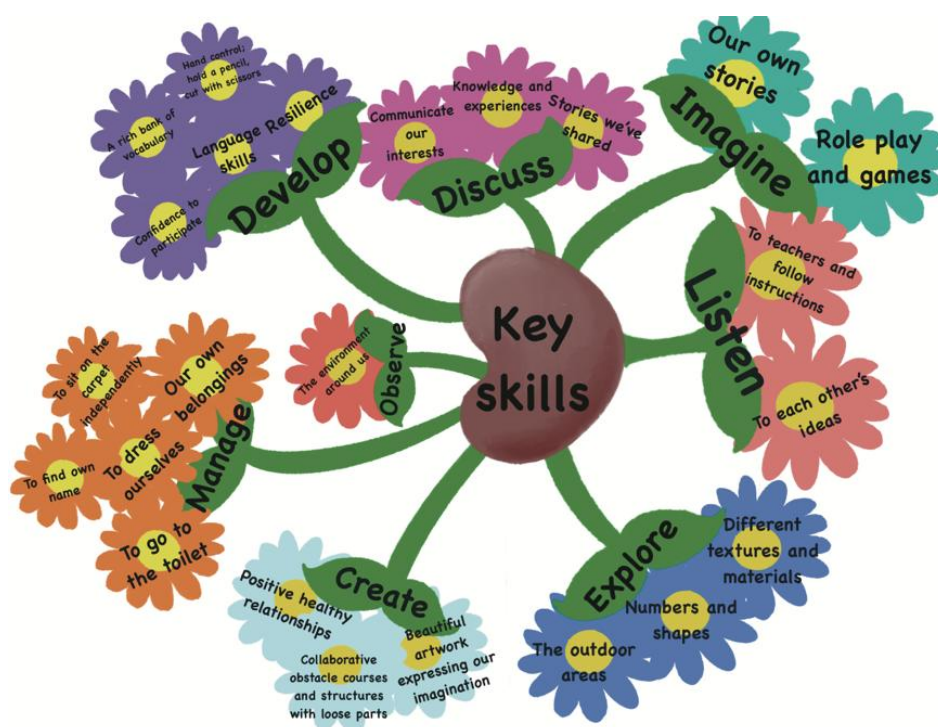




Our Curriculum Aims

We provide a vast and varied range of opportunities to develop key skills. These skills ensure that:



- 1) Children can confidently explore the entire Nursery provision and independently choose activities.
- 2) Children can understand our routines and can make sensible choices to help them follow these.
- 3) Children can understand individual differences and show empathy towards others.
- 4) Children can persevere with activities or skills they find tricky, through a 'do, repeat, refine' learning process to embed critical thinking, problem solving and resilience.
- 5) Children can confidently use numbers, shape and pattern.
- 6) Children can use a wide and varied vocabulary.
- 7) Children can recognise their name and are beginning to identify sounds, rhyme and alliteration.
- 8) Children can talk knowledgeably about books they enjoy.
- 9) Children can use their imaginations to create stories and engage in role-play to make sense of their world.
- 10) Children can confidently use tools (e.g. scissors, hammers, pens, brushes) with control to create.
- 11) Children know how to keep themselves safe and healthy.
- 12) Children can confidently use all our garden equipment and can explore movement through dance.
- 13) Children can independently go to the toilet, wash their hands, dress themselves and take responsibility for their belongings.
- 14) Children can talk knowledgeably about our local environment.
